1. Outline progress over the last 6 months (April – September) against the agreed project implementation timetable (if your project started less than 6 months ago, please report on the period since start up to end of September).

The first Project Management Team (PMT) meeting of the project took place on 6<sup>th</sup> September 2024 to discuss progress on Letter of Agreements (LoA) between CIFOR and partners, research planning and research permits application.

Up to date, LoAs have been finalized, and signed by parties. These LoAs will allow transfer of funds to the partners.

A detailed research plan was developed by IIAP (Output 2) for starting field activities mid-October. However, the regions of Amazonas, San Martín and Ucayali were placed under state of emergency mid-September, following forest fires seriously affecting them. Therefore, a decision was made to postpone field work to the third week of November. Thereafter, given that funds have not been transferred yet to IIAP, and that the rainy season will start beginnings of December until June-May, field work for this Output may be postponed to mid-year 2025. Application for research permits in the study areas were submitted to SERNANP and SERFOR in September. These are being processed by the corresponding authorities.

As agreed between CIFOR and IIAP, a total amount of GBP was reallocated from the IIAP budget to the CIFOR budget to hire a consultant that will deliver project outputs that are part of IIAP deliverables.
